Bar/Bat Mitzvah Service Videography Policy:

1. The videographer and video equipment must be unseen, tripod-mounted and remain hidden in the wall pocket throughout the service.
2. No videography is to occur outside of the wall pocket prior to the service.
3. The videographer must dress in attire appropriate to the sanctity of the synagogue service.
4. The videographer may not use an audible pager or cell phone.
5. There is to be no flash, artificial light or any sound emitting from equipment whatsoever.
6. Equipment must be setup prior to the beginning of the service and removed after its conclusion.
7. Temple Sinai assumes no responsibility for the security of the video equipment.
8. Temple Sinai assumes no risk for the synagogue sound, electrical and lighting system that may influence the quality of the video.
9. No financial transaction may take place on the Sabbath.
10. If the videographer has not previously filmed the synagogue service from within the wall pocket at Temple Sinai, he/she must arrange to meet with Ed Altman (TS Executive Director) at least one week prior to the date of your function to go over the setup and regulations.
11. PRIOR to the above-mentioned meeting, the videographer must provide a certificate of insurance to leave on file in the synagogue office as a condition of being allowed to work at Temple Sinai.
12. If the Bar/Bat Mitzvah service is shared with another family, the families must agree on a **SINGLE** videographer with the terms mutually agreeable to both families.
13. In order to provide this video option to our families and to insure the beauty and sanctity of your *simcha*, we ask that you carefully adhere to the policy as outlined above.
